### About Cobb+Co Museum

Cobb+Co Museum, a campus of the Queensland Museum is home to the National Carriage Collection, Australia's finest collection of horse-drawn vehicles. As well as Cobb and Co. coaches, the Collection has examples of the vast range of vehicles from the horse-drawn era — from farm wagons, hawkers barrows, delivery carts and buggies, to the elegant Landau, the Rolls Royce of carriages.

Located in Toowoomba, the Garden City of Queensland just west of Brisbane, Cobb+Co Museum also features extensive displays on the natural and cultural history of Toowoomba and the Darling Downs, providing a fascinating insight for visitors to the region

The Museum is open 10am–4pm every day, except on ANZAC Day, Good Friday and Christmas Day

### Something for everyone

Cobb+Co Museum is suitable for all ages and interest levels. There is more than enough for everyone to enjoy, but for those with a more specialised interest in the carriage collection, further details are available. Children are catered for with The Coach Stop, an interactive discovery centre.

Cobb+Co Museum is climate-controlled, so is a comfortable temperature all year round. The Museum, including the toilet facilities, is fully wheelchair accessible with ramps to all areas. There are ample seats throughout the Museum for people with mobility difficulties.

### Getting more from your visit

Guided tours are available by prior arrangement. The tours can be tailored to suit the interests of the group.

Cobb's Coffee Shop provides a range of refreshment options for morning/afternoon tea and lunch, including home-made soup or a sausage sizzle.

The Museum's gift shop stocks a range of Queensland Museum publications, education games, books and Cobb and Co. clocks.
